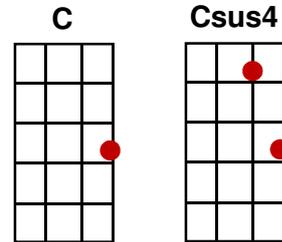
Intro: // // ↓

And we shall row my love and I

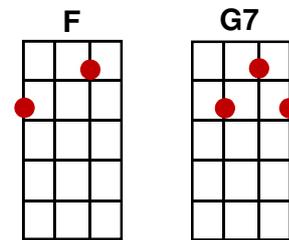


A ship there is that sails the sea,

And I know not how I'll sink or swim.

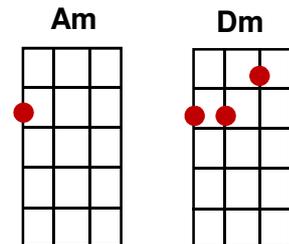


For love is gentle and love is fine,
