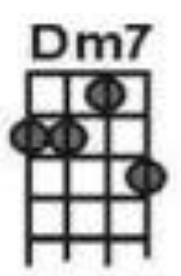
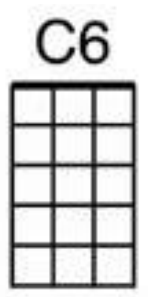


C G7 C6 G7
