C Am D Am Am

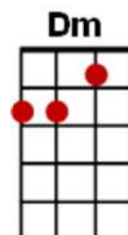
Parsley, sage, rosemary and thyme

C Am D Am Am

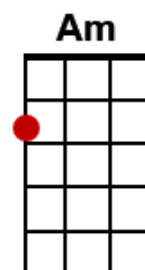
Parsley, sage, rosemary and thyme

C Am D Am Am

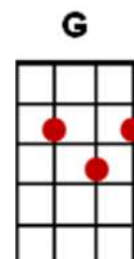
Parsley, sage, rosemary and thyme
